

Included in this box:

(1) Budget Buck (1) skull template (3) 2" screws

Tools and materials Required:



Deer antlers
Power Drill
1/8" bit
1/4" bit
scissors
or (diagonal pliers/sheers)
towel or blanket

Preparation



Assembly will be easier with a friend or assistant! Please be reminded that when using Budget Buck with deer skulls, it is best that the original deer skull is cleaned of all meat and flesh, then washed well and dried. Budget Buck staff recommends that original deer skulls are cleaned very well and air dried.

Caution: The Budget Buck is an Art Piece, Not A Toy. Handle with respect. **FLAMABLE:** Do not store near open flame or other heat source.



STEP 1

Using the Budget Buck skull template, cut deer skull to fit pattern, and using the same template, drill the three 1/4 inch holes in skull for attachment to Budget Buck receiving plate.

Using a folded towel or blanket to protect Budget Buck from scrapes and scratches, have an assistant hold Budget Buck upright, and, lifting flap on top of Budget Buck, fit the deer antler skull plate to the Budget Buck receiving pad. (Photo A) Trim skull if necessary.

Having the assistant hold the Budget Buck flap open, hold the deer skull plate in position over the Budget Buck receiving pad and using the three pre-drilled holes in the deer skull, drill one hole in the Budget Buck receiving pad using the 1/8 inch drill bit. Budget Buck staff has found that drilling the BACK hole first, and attaching a single screw first will aid in centering and leveling the deer skull onto the Budget Buck receiving pad. (Photo B)

Screw the front two screws into place, securing the deer skull onto the Budget Buck, and flip the Budget Buck flap back over the deerskull. (Photo C)

STEP 2

Using your choice of scissors, diagonal pliers or sheers, clip into the antler openings on the flap around each antler burr, approximately 1/4 inch apart. Trim tabs to fit at base of antler burr. (Photo D)

STEP 3

You're done! Hang your Budget Buck! To hang Budget Buck, simply screw a 3 inch drywall screw halfway into the wall at a forty-five degree angle upwards, and place Budget Buck onto screw. Step back, and enjoy your trophy artwork!
